



Greenacres 2021 Summer Camp COVID-19 Guidelines

Guardians of our campers have reviewed the following guidelines regarding COVID-19 with their children and the drop-off/pick-up point person, if applicable, prior to camp:

The safety of our staff and visitors has always been a top priority at Greenacres. Please note, these guidelines are subject to change as we continuously monitor federal and state protocols. In order to provide the safest experience for your family we require these guidelines to be followed:

- o Plan to arrive 15 minutes before your program as all participants will complete a health screening conducted by Greenacres staff members. If you arrive earlier than 15 minutes before the program, please stay in your vehicle.
- o The following health screening will occur each day:
 - § A temperature check: Any person with a temperature over 100 degrees will need to return home.
 - § Complete a questionnaire. If a camper responds with 'yes' to any of these questions, they cannot enter Greenacres property:
 - § In the last 14 days, have you tested positive OR are waiting on test results for COVID-19?
 - § In the last 14 days, to the best of your knowledge, have you had close contact (within 6 feet for about 15 minutes) with someone who tested positive for COVID-19?
 - § Within the last 24 hours, have you displayed any of the following symptoms: cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, fever, new loss of taste or smell?
- o All individuals attending camp will be required to wear a mask or face covering at all times, with the exception of mask breaks, eating and drinking. Equine educators may remove masks during distanced, mounted lessons in the open-air arena. For equine riding activities only, riders are not required to wear their mask once mounted, but are kept on their person. Acceptable masks include disposable or cloth masks; face shields alone are not acceptable.
- o Experiences will allow for social distancing.
- o Access to soap and water or hand sanitizer will be available at all times.
- o Drinking from the water fountains will be prohibited. Please bring a personal water bottle. Refill stations will be available.
- o Materials used for camp will be limited, however when necessary, items will be sanitized between uses.
- o Eating and drinking will only take place outside and/or in well ventilated, open-air spaces with campers distanced over 6 feet.
- o Mask breaks are built into the schedule periodically throughout each day for less than 15 minutes at a time and will be held outside and/or in well ventilated, open-air spaces, with campers distanced at least 6 feet.
- o Camp will be held outside and/or in well ventilated, open-air spaces as much as possible. Please dress appropriately for the weather.
- o If Greenacres is notified of a camper, leader in training or Greenacres educator testing positive within 10 days after the last day of camp or potential exposure, emergency contacts of that camp group will be notified. Greenacres will not share personally identifiable information about individuals who have tested positive. If your camper tests positive within 10 days after the last day of camp, please notify us via email at camp@green-acres.org.
- o If a camp would include family audiences, parents would be notified ahead of time with the time and location, and would adhere to the same COVID guidelines as campers.
