

GAPC Event Volunteers Policy

General Overnight/Hotel Policy

- No more than 2 Chaperones per room on overnight events
- No more than 5 Pony Clubbers per room on overnight events

Quiz and Rally

- Drivers may receive mileage reimbursement for the event (Mileage Reimbursement Forms to be completed by the end of the event)
- Parents signing up to fill Greenacres volunteer positions will have their rooms paid for by Pony Clubbers attending the event. Other parents attending are responsible for the costs of their rooms.
- Volunteers may request a single room at a hotel, but will be billed for the difference of a room shared with a second volunteer (i.e. you will be billed personally for half the room cost)

Additional Policies

- In order for their child to be in “good standing,” parents must volunteer for Quiz OR Rally OR four on-site show positions.
- If your child participates at Pony Club Championships, you are expected to attend and/or drive.
- If your child is attending a non-PC sponsored off-site show, a parent MUST be prepared to drive to/from the show, supply food and beverages and assist in anyway needed at the show. For the safety of the riders, one parent from the group competing must be present at all times for the duration of the show. I cannot accommodate all riders in my truck (it only seats 5 + the driver). We often take additional members along as grooms- this makes for a much easier, less stressful event for the riders- these members taking the time to go as “slave labor” for the day will get first “dibbs” on seats in the truck.
- If your child is riding in an off-site event, they are required to do the following:
 - Be available in advance to set up trailer and prep horse for the event
 - Attend the ENTIRE event from loading the horse onto the trailer to cleaning out the trailer after the event – they do NOT have permission to leave the event early or miss set up/clean up for any reason.
 - Parents/Drivers/Riders attending the event must plan to caravan with the trailer to ALL shows. This is a safety issue- should something happen while traveling to/from an event, we MUST have each rider handling their own horse (ie- do NOT as parents, just “meet us back at the barn” with your rider- we need ALL riders to be present and available should an emergency happen while traveling).
